1. Mobility rate for funded persons

Travel expense allowance for students, graduates, doctoral candidates, postdoctoral researchers and professors for trips to Greece or from Greece to Germany amounting to **300 EUR**. Travel expenses for employees of German universities for trips to Greece or from Greece to Germany in accordance with the LRKG (Landesreisekostengesetz), at most according to BRKG (Bundesreisekostengesetz), 2nd class train journey, economy class flights.

2. Subsidy rates for funded persons

The day of arrival and departure count together as one day. Contributions to the foreign health insurance are to be paid from the subsidy rates. Any tuition fees that may arise are eligible for funding.
